

**VILLAGE OF WARNER
IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA**

BYLAW NO. 533-12

A Bylaw of the Village of Warner in the Province of Alberta for the purpose of closing to public travel public roads (lanes) to create titles in the name of the municipality in accordance with Section 22 of the Municipal Government Act, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, Chapter M-26, as amended.

WHEREAS the lands hereafter described, and as illustrated in attached Schedule 'A' are no longer required for public travel; and

WHEREAS application has been made to Council to have the roadways closed; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Village of Warner deems it expedient to provide for a bylaw for the purpose of closing to public travel certain roads, or portions thereof, situated in the said municipality, and therefore creating title to same; and

WHEREAS notice of the intention of Council to pass a bylaw has been given in accordance with Section 606 of the Municipal Government Act; and

WHEREAS Council was not petitioned for an opportunity to be heard by any person claiming to be prejudicially affected by the bylaw.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the Village of Warner in the Province of Alberta does hereby close to public travel for the purpose of creating title to the following described roadways, subject to rights of access granted by other legislation:

ALL OF LANE ADJACENT TO LOTS 1 TO 12 INCLUSIVE, BLOCK 31, PLAN 6442Y AND
ALL OF LANE ADJACENT TO AND LYING NORTH OF LOTS 13 TO 20 INCLUSIVE, BLOCK
31, PLAN 6442Y ALL WITHIN SE¼ SEC 10, TWP 17, RGE 17, W4M

EXCEPTING THEREOUT ALL MINES AND MINERALS
